This is a summary of the learning programme for your child this term;

	English	The children this term we will be learning the remaining spelling patterns, punctuation and grammar for Year 6, as well as practising their reading comprehension skills. Where possible we will link our writing to our topic Raging Rivers. Please ensure that your child is reading at least 3 times a week at home and quizzing regularly on their Accelerated reading books.
	Maths	In this final term the maths focus will be: measures, including converting between metric measures and solving multistep problems; ratio and proportion problems; algebra, including using and solving simple equations and geometry, looking at the properties of 2D and 3D shapes. Please make sure your child continues to practise their times tables and completes their weekly homework.
	Topic	Our summer term topic is Raging Rivers. We will learn about the different sections of a river and how they are formed, building on Science done in Year 3 on different types of rock. During the topic the children will also learn about some famous rivers around the world.
	Science	This term in Science we will focus on light, exploring how light travels and how we are able to see objects, and electricity, where the children will investigate circuits that include buzzers and motors and will use symbols to draw circuit diagrams.
	Religious Education	In RE we will be exploring the children's ideas of what God is like and how 'god' is represented differently in different faiths. We will be learning about Jesus the Saviour. We will also be starting our new RE curriculum about Humanism.
	PSHRE	Moving On: This term we will have discussions with the children about their move to secondary school allowing them to talk through any concerns they may have. The children will be thinking about new starts, making good first impressions and what their ambitious and hopes are for the future.
	Computing	In computing the children will be continuing to develop their coding skills, using Espresso Coding. They will also use Teams to share a document to work on, linked to the Raging Rivers Project.
	PE	In PE the pupils will be taught by our specialist coach Mr Davies and they will focus on cricket and athletics. With ourselves, the children will take part in lessons on rounders and sports day practice.
	Language	In French children will learn about telling the time and talking about the school week.
